


SANREMO GENOA PORTOFINO LA SPEZIA PORTOVENERE

The oldest part of the city is known as "Pigna": passed the riots of San Sebastiano, through the multitude of old paths, as "Via Palma", you will appreciate churches, little squares, oratories but, most important, the amazing Chatedral of "Madonna della Costa".

The city center, "Via Matteotti", starts from the beautiful "Colombo Square", and proceeds until the majestic "Casino".


Full of various shops, where you can have some luxury shopping, in Via Matteotti you will meet one of the most famous theatres in the World, "Ariston theatre", where since 1951 the most important international artists, get together for the "Festival of the italian song".

For its fastastic weather and its amazing territory, in 2009 Sanremo had the honor to inaugurate a 24 km of Cycle lane wich has no equal in Europe. Here, you will live the experience of riding next to the sea, through the amazing flowers and flora typical of this city.

During the centuries, Sanremo has been known as a "Little Maritime Center", and the heart of the maritime life was the ancient "Bresca Square": today, the fish market and the fisherman who interlaced nets, have been replaced by the most luxurious pubs and restaurants of the city, and "Bresca Square" became the "heart of movida", preserving anyway its marine features.

With its Golf Club, its infinite golden seasides, its amazing hinterland and its multitude of Wellness centers, Sanremo is a city to be lived!



Genoa



Ligurian chief town, known as "La Superba", Genoa overlooks the gulf of Liguria.

Its history is based on maritime commerce and its port is the biggest and most important in Italy, and the second one all over Mediterranean sea.

Genoa offers also a mix of history, art, letterature and music that in 2004 gave to this amazing city the title of "European Culture's Capital".

The "Old Genoa" is a maze of little pedestrian streets full of ancient shops, known as "Carrugi", that will leave you breathless. Here, you will appreciate a perfect example of romanesque - gothic architecture, on visiting the famous "San Lorenzo Chatedral", but also the most monumental road of the old town, "Garibaldi street", where all patrician buildings, built between XVI and XVII century, are protected by "UNESCO" since 2006.

The city center starts from the amazing Vittoria Square and proceeds until the glamourous Via Roma.

The most popular street is surely Via XX Settembre that, with its typical arcades crossed by lot of little streets, abounds of all types of shops.

Melting – pot between Via XX Settembre and Via Roma is the renowned "De Ferrari Square", where you can visit "Carlo Felice" Theatre, or maybe appreciate a vernissage inside "Palazzo Ducale".

Finally, if you're looking for luxury shops, in Via Roma you will find best brands, as Louis Vuitton, Prada, Dolce Gabbana and more.

The old port gives to Genoa a symbolic value.

Here you will discover the real maritime soul of Genoa, through a visit of the Maritime Museum "Galata", the biggest of Mediterranean Sea, dedicated to navigation history.

The main attraction for who loves the sea is surely the famous "Aquarium", the biggest italian aquarium, inaugurated in 1992, that hosts 600 different marine species.

La Spezia & Porto Venere





La Spezia, Porto Venere and a few small villages forming the Gulf of Poets, a territory composed by rugged hills and amazing beaches.

Second most populated city of Liguria, La Spezia is known for its shipyards but also for its medieval borough, witness of ancient traditions.

Castello di San Giorgio is one of the most important attraction, ancient Castle of the republic of Genoa. Here you can find an interesting selection of local archaeologicals finds.

Art, nature and sea are three elements that characterise Porto Venere, with its small dock at the feet of the ancient suburb. The city climbs through steep stairways coasted along from colored houses and the Mediterranean wood.
